

## BDHP Cancer Theme Applications for funding

### **Background**

BDHP organisations have contributed funding to support projects that generate new linkages across the BDHP network, through new and expanded collaborations and shared resources. As a result, three grants of between \$10,000 - \$20,000 are available for new and expanded collaborations across BDHP partners that focus on one of the below Medical Research Future Fund (MRFF) priority areas:

#### **Strategic and International Horizons**

1. One Health – Antimicrobial Resistance
2. Global Health and Health Security
3. Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Health
4. Ageing and Aged Care

#### **Data and Infrastructure**

5. Digital Health Intelligence

#### **Health Services and Systems**

6. Comparative Effectiveness Research
7. Primary Care Research

#### **Capacity and Collaboration**

8. Clinical Researcher Capacity
9. Consumer-Driven Research

#### **Trials and Translation**

10. Drug Repurposing
11. Public Health Interventions

#### **Commercialisation**

12. Translational Research Infrastructure

### **Selection criteria**

1. Focuses on an area of cancer control – from prevention, diagnosis, treatment to outreach / education.
2. Involves a minimum of 3 BDHP organisations and must include a clinician
3. Relates to a MRFF priority area
4. Generates a new / expanded collaboration
5. Good progress can be demonstrated within 6 months of receiving grant

### **Exclusion criteria**

1. Funding cannot be used for the purchase or hire of equipment
